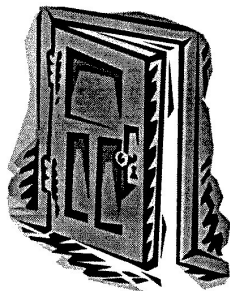


Pool Etiquette
