## City offers loans for home repairs & improvements

Home rehabilitation loans are available to Santa Clara home owners who need financial help. The funds can be used for a variety of repairs and improvements such as re-roofing, plumbing, electrical, heating/cooling, termite damage, handicap access, foundation, weatherization or other projects to make the house move safe and livable. The City's Neighborhood Conservation & Improvement program has been in existence since 1976 and has helped more than 2,000 home owners improve their property and their neighborhoods. Home owners who qualify are offered a loan at a 2% simple annual interest rate. The loan is deferred for 20 years and repaid when the house is sold or transferred. Some applicants may also receive a full or partial grant from the city, which does not have to be repaid. 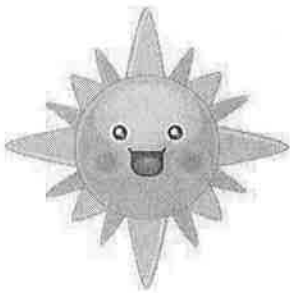



**MAKE IT**

- ADD boiling water to gelatin mix in medium bowl; stir 2 min, until completely dissolved.
- MICROWAVE evaporated milk and chocolate in microwaveable bowl on HIGH 2 min, or until chocolate is melted and mixture is blended, stirring each minute. Add to gelatin; whisk until blended.
- POUR into 14 (3 oz.) paper cups sprayed with cooking spray; Refrigerate 15 min.
- TOP with cherries, pressing in slightly to stick. Refrigerate 20 min, or until firm. Unmold to serve.

**WHAT YOU NEED**

- 6/3 cup boiling water
- 1 pkg. (3 oz.) JELL-O Cherry Flavor Gelatin
- 1 can (5 oz.) evaporated milk
