RECURRING PROBLEM WITH TRASH & RECYCLING BINS

The garbage trucks grab these bins mechanically to lift and empty them. Then the same mechanism brings the bins down to the ground and pushes them back away from the truck. When you place your bins close to the building wall, garage door, exposed water pipes and spigots where hoses attach, the trucks throw your bin back against these surfaces and sometimes cause damage. While the garbage company is responsible for the damage they do, this can all be minimized if residents would make a point to keep bins at least 2 feet out away from the edge of the garage when bins are placed out for collection day.
